WELCOME BACK STUDENTS!!!

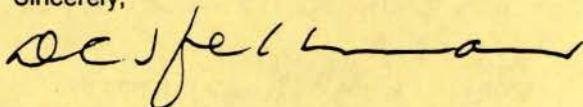

Students are reminded that pre-registration for classes will not become official until the student signs in at the Registrar's Office on the first day of general registration at the beginning of each semester.

The first day of general registration for the 1990 Spring Semester was January 9; however, the deadline has been extended to January 10.

Failure to sign-in today will result in automatic withdrawal from your pre-registered classes. If you haven't signed in, bring some form of identification to the Registrar's Office and **DO IT TODAY.**

If correct volume and issue numbers do not appear on your Purchase Order Requisition, your publication may not be approved for printing or copying, which may result in a publication delay.

The College Archives and Public Relations Offices have requested this procedure to insure the historical integrity of all Lindenwood College publications. Beginning January 10, 1990, anyone producing a Lindenwood publication must sign-up for the current volume and new issue number at the bulletin board in the Public Relations Office.

Also, please remember to send at least two copies of your printed publication to the College Archives, Attn: Miss Mary Ambler, Butler Library. Miss Ambler, Virginia Terry and other alumni assistants volunteer time weekly to preserve the heritage of Lindenwood College. By using correct volume and issue numbers, plus the date of publication; we, too, can help preserve Lindenwood's legacy.
