Afton said, "This year, I wanted to incorporate bold colors and embellishments of knits to make the simplest garment look extraordinary, all the while following the color card for spring and summer 2007."

SHERYL GRAHAM - URBAN FLIRT: AN IRISH SPRING/SUMMER

Sheryl earned her BFA in Studio Art and became a successful practicing artist for 2 years. However, after nine years of retail, visual merchandising, and window dressing experience, she was inspired to branch out into fashion design. Sheryl loves to experiment with color, texture, and patterns, and has discreetly infused the colors of the Irish Flag in her Senior Collection. She combines the essence of her home country—the tonal Irish landscape—with a cheeky twist that is fit for the cityscape. Sheryl is interested in irony and tries to create a visual interest by challenging the 'norm.' She uses the interplay of composition, asymmetry, and balance with a result that is pretty but funky. Sheryl will continue to create in the future with aspirations of producing her own line, and hopes to round out her experience by trying her hand at styling.
