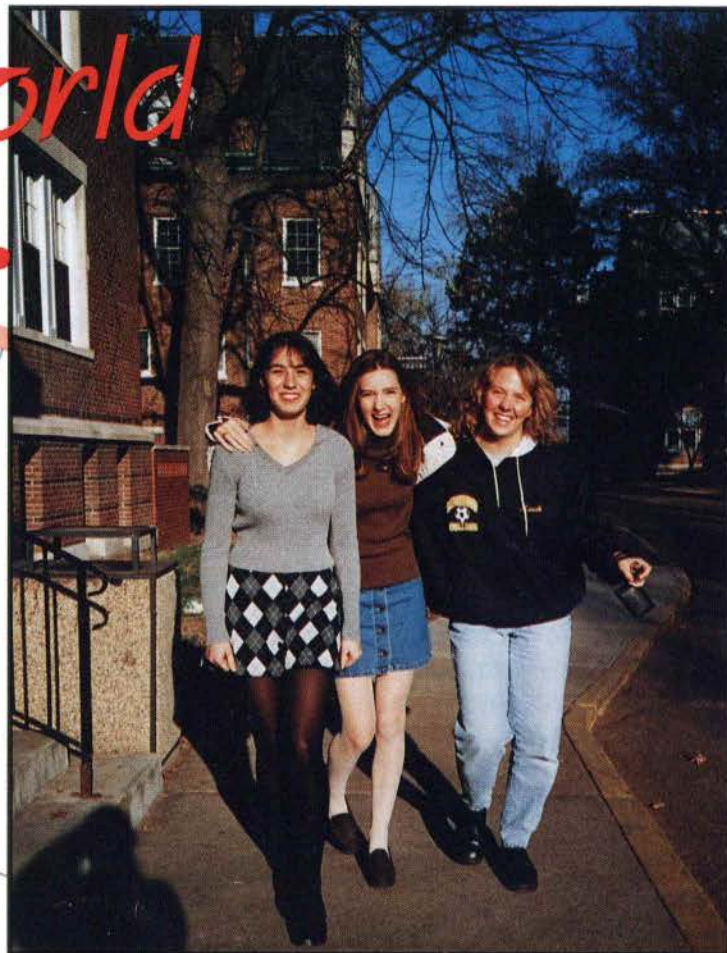

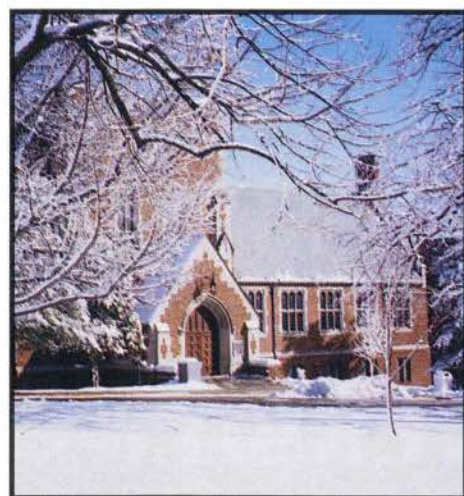
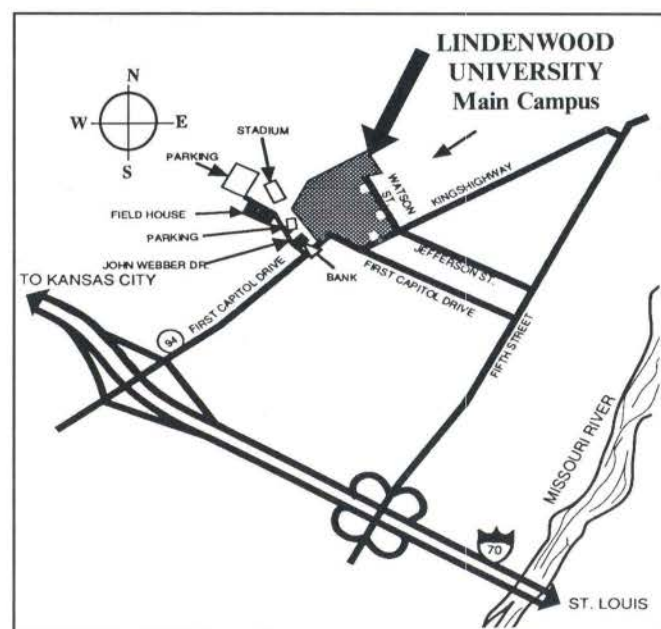

We're minutes away from metropolitan St. Louis.

The main 258 acre residential campus is located in St. Charles, Missouri. Resting on the banks of the Missouri River, St. Charles is the site of Missouri's first state capital.

Lindenwood is close to St. Louis, a city offering everything from professional sports—the Cardinals, the Rams, the Blues, and the Ambush—to an internationally recognized zoo. There are touring Broadway shows at the Fabulous Fox Theatre and the Muni Opera, as well as superstar concerts at the Kiel Center and Riverport Amphitheatre. The St. Louis-Lambert International Airport is just minutes from the University.

At Lindenwood you'll find a home away from home.

At Lindenwood, full-time resident students live in residential halls and several houses located on the beautifully wooded campus. Daily meals are served in Ayres Dining Hall.

The University's oldest building, Sibley Hall, is a tribute to Lindenwood's founders Major George C. and Mary Easton Sibley. Built in 1856, it is listed in the National Register of Historic Places and serves as a women's dormitory. The University has a historical relationship with the Presbyterian Church and is committed to the values inherent in the Judaeo-Christian tradition.

The College takes pride in its illustrious alumni group who demonstrate the continuing benefits of Lindenwood's liberal arts education. 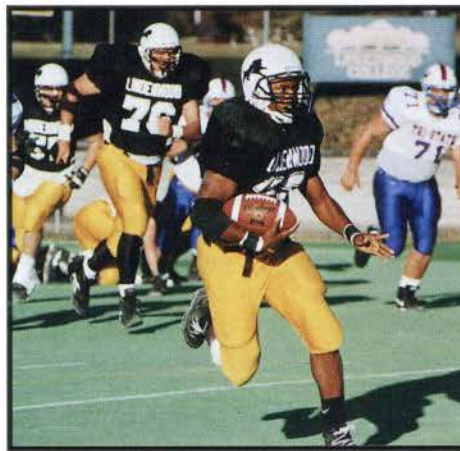
Real challenges

Lindenwood University offers students the opportunity to participate in athletics.

We field 19 varsity sports, including champions in women's soccer, men and women's cross country, and wrestling. Lindenwood has a nationally ranked men's soccer program as well. The athletic teams compete in the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA), and the Heart of America Athletic Conference. Students may also audition for the cheerleading squad, spirit squad, and the award-winning Lion Line Dance Squad.

The University's football and soccer teams play in the Harlen C. Hunter Stadium which has an artificial turf field and a seating capacity of 5,000. Newly constructed softball and baseball fields and an all-weather outdoor track are located on the southwest corner of the campus. The Lindenwood Lions and Lady Lions basketball, volleyball, and wrestling teams compete in the new 3,000 seat Robert F. Hyland Performance Arena.

All students have complete access to the fully equipped fitness center, which includes free weights, weight and stairstep machines, stationary bicycles, an indoor track, and a combination wrestling/dance floor.

Admission to Lindenwood University is evaluated on an individual basis and is based largely on an analysis of your grade point average (GPA), and ACT or SAT scores. Extracurricular activities, recommendations and personal character are also considered.
