The President of the United States has appointed you a Commissioner (in place of Col. P. Menard resigned) conjointly with George C Sibley and Benjⁿ H Reeves Esquires to carry into effect the objects contemplated by the act of Congress ^{of the 3^d March last} authorizing the President to cause a road to be marked out from the western frontier of Missouri to the confines of Mexico, and to hold Treaties with certain Indian Tribes.

Your Commission and copies of the instructions issued to the other members of the Commission will be forwarded to you at St. Louis.
