and School House for the year 1888 at
50¢ per year - the Regular place of meet-
ing is to be at P. Stein Office. the said
P. Stein furnishing light and fuel free
charges. it was ordered by the Board
the full amount of Taxes be Collected from
all Common property. no Reduction
to be made. On Motion Ben Maas was
appointed to purchase 2000 feet Oak Lumber
for the Town. the Boarding no further
