I met with our CFO Rick Baniak to review the FY22 budget. We brought in \$9.2M less revenue than expected but are still maintaining a small positive margin. We need to continue to watch spending so we stay on track and can invest more into the university. This is not an easy balance, but we've focused our spending to drive enrollment and philanthropy.
