In my letter of the - first
I mentioned the convention of the
Board of the Mexia Road Comrs on
the 4th proximo in Jefferson.
Since which time & before I had
forwarded a similar note to
Majr Libby I recd a letter from
Mr Libby mentioning his acquies-
ence as to that place at my
urgent request & mentioned that
he would be at my house on his
way to St Louis & that when he arrived
he would agree upon the day & he
would communicate to you & that

be expected you would accompany him
to Jefferson & in the mean time
Mr L requested me to write on & engage
several lodgings &c which I have
done

to go to the Eastward & so I hope Mrs
Mather will communicate this fact
to me
