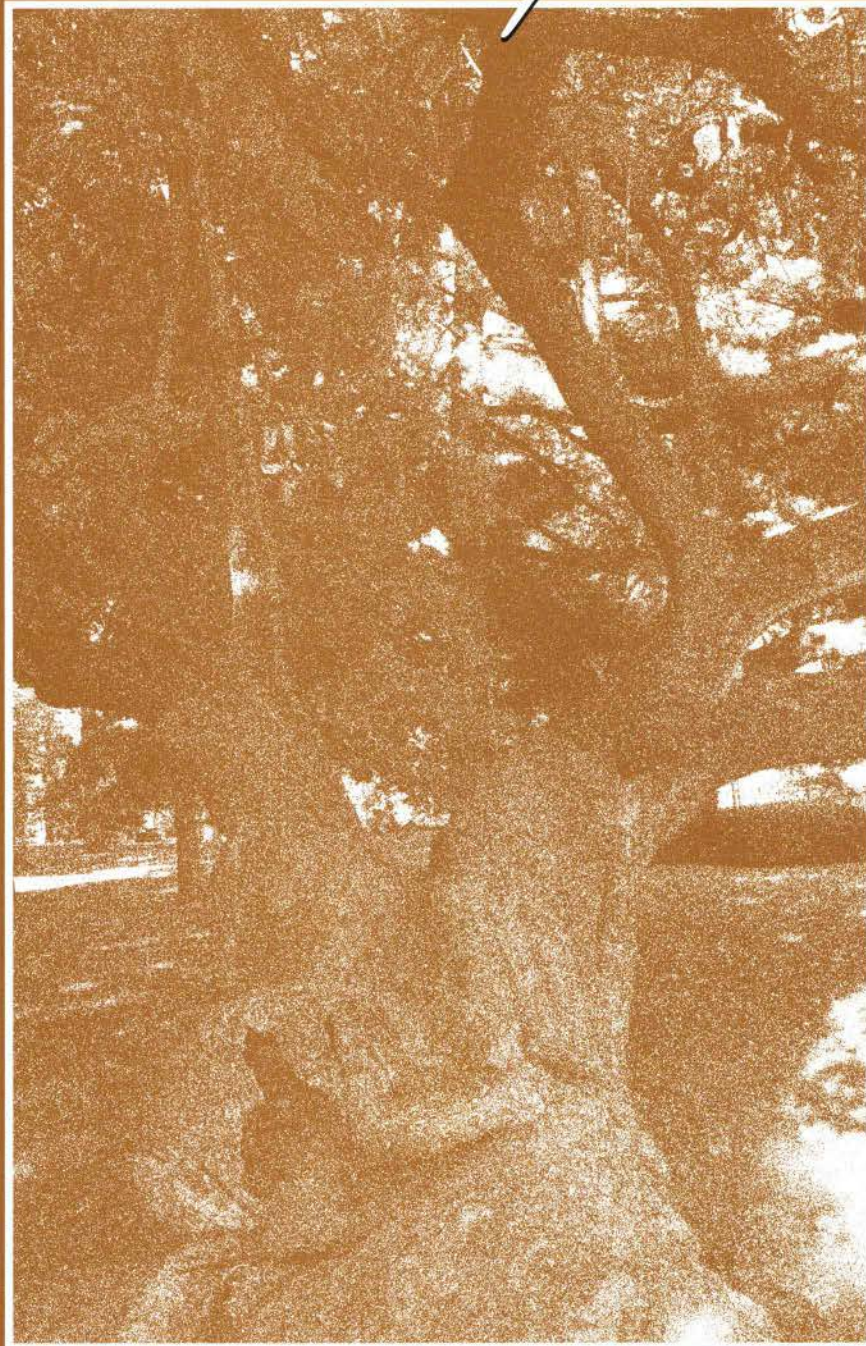

Dear Friends,

My first fiscal year as President of Lindenwood University recently came to an end. It has been the most rewarding year of the 33 I've had at this institution — a year I will always remember.

Student enrollment here continues to grow. We are investing wisely, and we are moving forward with numerous academic and facility endeavors to make sure Lindenwood remains a great place to learn. It is truly an honor to be at the helm of a strong, successful institution of higher learning. As has been customary in this document, I am proud to report that, due in no small part to the help of our friends and alumni, the university remains debt-free. This desirable situation enables us to keep tuition very reasonable even as we expand our facilities and personnel to better serve the students.

Our future is full of promise and stimulating challenges. We continue this year with our Create the Future capital campaign, and we are about to launch the portion of the campaign dedicated to the renovation of our beloved Harmon Hall. In addition, we have set an ambitious endowment target — \$200 million by 2027. That is the 200th anniversary of Lindenwood and the 100th anniversary of the construction of our storied entry gate. We are making very good progress toward the 2027 goal. In the fiscal year just ended, the university's endowment climbed from just over \$50 million to approximately \$70 million!

Please know that your Lindenwood will stay independent and will continue to have as its top priority remaining a student-centered place of learning. We will remain fiscally responsible and continue to deliver high-quality programs. As well, we will offer new programs as warranted by Lindenwood's mission and today's higher education marketplace. The importance of values and character will continue to be a high priority at LU.

### Appreciated Real Property

Donations of appreciated property can allow for both a generous contribution to Lindenwood and have financial benefits for you.

### Gifts of Securities

Transfer of stock and other appreciated securities to Lindenwood can provide you a substantial tax savings. Donors can receive an income tax deduction equal to the fair market value of the stock on the date of the gift — thus reducing your taxable capital gains.

### Charitable Gift Annuity

This gift frees up your assets in order to generate current income to you during your lifetime. You make an initial gift to Lindenwood and then a set payment is paid during your lifetime, or at a designated time such as retirement.

### Charitable Remainder Trust

This is a managed and invested trust that provides you and/or other beneficiaries you name with a stream of income for life or a period of years. # Endowed Scholarships

Interest generated by the fund may be held and applied to the principal to help complete the fund or may be blended with other endowment interest to award scholarships until the fund reaches \$25,000. Only the interest generated by the fund is awarded. The corpus or principal of the fund is invested and is not distributed.
