ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIPS

The purpose of the Endowed Scholarship Program at Lindenwood University is to assist deserving young men and women in financing their education and to recognize the generosity of the individual donors who support and encourage them. Lindenwood University accepts students from a large pool of outstanding applicants each year, but many of them cannot pursue their educational goals without financial assistance. These scholarships, combined with other assistance such as Work and Learn, provide students the opportunity to achieve their goals at Lindenwood.

A scholarship is fully endowed when the fund principal meets or exceeds \$20,000. An individual, family, group of friends, or a business may establish an endowed scholarship fund with an initial gift of \$1,000. Additional gifts will be applied to the fund principal as they are received. Interest generated by the fund may be held and applied to the principal to help complete the fund or may be blended with other endowment interest to award scholarships until the fund reaches \$20,000. Only the interest generated by the fund is awarded. The corpus or principal of the fund is invested and is not distributed.

Your gift to a Lindenwood University endowed scholarship fund may also be easily multiplied because many companies will match the contributions of their employees and retirees.
