Sir,

I have this day Requested Mr. John G. Comegys of St. Louis to pay you on demand the Sum of Seventy-five Dollars Cash on account of the hire of your Megro boy Boch, which Sum you will call for when you think proper, & Receipt to him for it. I Shd. have Sent you this money Sooner, but could find no conveyance to you direct that I approved of Your boy is in good health, conducts himself pretty well, and you will think him much improved when you See him.

Having been disappointed in getting another Servant from St. Louis, I am induced to keep Boch a few months longer; probably I Shall Send him home in May or perhaps Sconer- whenever I Send him you will at the Same time Receive payment in full for his hire- Please to make my Compts. acceptable to Mrs. C. & belive me to be Sir
