I have till within a few days ago had to attend (Medically) to the Spanish & American Troops here, the Spaniards are gone & a Doctor of the United States Army has arrived here to Attend the Garrison, which consists of about Sixty Persons, tho. some more will probably be Sent here, my attending them confined me too much & interfered very much with my other Practice, which is very extensive- I mean very much Scattered. offer my Compts to Messrs Levi & Carroll- And Expect to hear from me again soon, Robert Armstrong of Raleigh is here.-- Am with Great Love & Esteeme
