“Mrs. Sibley’s school is as yet small but increasing, and next spring it is to be opened on a much more extended scale, and Mrs. Strong is at present sole instructress – with how much dignity and success she presides in her new sphere, –others should speak, – tho’ I may safely say I find no difficulty in pleasing my employers and in gaining the confidence and affection of the young ladies. It furnishes a wide field of usefulness and gives me power over Mrs.S. in the right state to receive.”
