### **DIRECTORS NOTE**

A wonderful fact to reflect upon, that every human creature is constituted to be that profound secret and mystery to every other. A solemn consideration, when I enter a great big city by night, that every one of those darkly clustered houses encloses its own secret; that every beating heart in the hundreds of thousands of breasts there, is, in some of its imaginings, a secret to the heart nearest it! Something of the awfulness, even of Death itself. is referable to this. No more can I turn the leaves of this dear book that I loved, and vainly hope in time to read it all ... It was appointed that the book should shut with a spring, for ever and for ever, when I had read but a page ... My friend is dead, my neighbor is dead, my love, the darling of my soul, is dead ... In any of the burial places of this city through which I pass, is there a sleeper more inscrutable than its busy inhabitants are, in their innermost personality, to me, or than I am to them? ... 
