

1956 BASEBALL BUSINESS SESSION

Sunday, February 19, 1956

The Business Session was called to order at 2:00 p.m. by Vice President Brooks who turned the meeting over to Baseball Council Chairman Terry to preside. The following were present : T. Brooks, E. Hester, D. Terry, J. Hester, M. Porter, N. Webb, W. Scott, J. Graham, B. Russell, C. Rayford, J. Hundley, F. Edwards, J. Johnson, T. Lyles, E. Chism, L. Pollard, B. Morris, J. Bryant, J. Essens, and J. Buckner.

The resume of the discussion held at the planning session of February 4, 1956 was reviewed. Recommendations and action taken at this business session will give final adoption to the proposals of the planning session.

The following were adopted for immediate use, unless rejected by the Executive Committee :

1. Reduce the number of eligible players on a team to fifteen. A team may use 17 men for the first two games but must cut to 15 before the third game.
2. Experiment for the month of May, 1956 playing a regulation nine inning game for all games. One o'clock starting time of first game - no grace period for tardy teams - second game to start 15 minutes after the first game with only one extra inning in case of tie in the first game.
3. Managers are responsible for the effectiveness of the above new experiments. All managers are to be notified and consulted for any extenuating circumstances requiring changes in game timing. Managers are responsible for practice time being observed - home team to practice first - teams to vacate field at once when practice time has expired. No extra time for teams starting late.
4. The 1956 season shall start on Sunday, May 6 with the four teams: Braves, Dodgers, Scullin and the Stars. Each team to receive copies of the newly published rules of the league.
5. No high school player who is eligible to play at school can play until the date of his last high school game. Such players may be signed at any time but will be counted in the fifteen only when eligible.
6. The Executive Secretary is authorized to accept Official team correspondence including contract and release cards, protests, etc. ONLY when signed by one of the following, unless changed in writing by the SPONSOR : Braves - F. Edwards; Dodgers - T. Lyles, J. Johnson; Scullin - W. Boswell, E. Chism; Stars - J. Hundley, C. Radford. No player may be signed after the eighth game.
7. The groundskeeper, Mr. Scott is to give special attention to the wet third base area, the holes in the protective screen, the practice area along first base. Mr. Webb volunteered to paint scoreboard on the shack.
