

Muny Pilots 18 Angry at Loss Of Playing Field Ú Managers of the North Side Muny Baseball League, along with its president, Roy Newsom, were up in arms at a meeting last night after they found out this past week that they will not be able to play their games this season on Diamond No. I at Fair-0 ground Park. Among those present, heside 0 0 Newsom, were Al Mick, of the city champion Kutis team: Lou M Boggiano, of Borbein-Young; Ed Moran and Al Rothmeyer of the Union Printers, and Stan Lesinski, representing John Zienta of The C.Y.C. picked Fairground the Polish Falcons. No. 1, after being given first le choice by the City's Baseball Advisory Board following a new policy of alloccation of diamonds for the coming season. Several meetings were held between the North Side group and 5 the C.Y.C. and the latter notified the Muny managers last Thursday that they intended retaining the rights to the field. The North Side League was alloted No. 2 at the same park Newsom said that both he and the managers feel that "we have no axe to grind with anyone, our only interest is to find out why after 20 years of the North Side League playing on No. 1 at Fairground we no longer are granted the right to it." Boggiano, who as a player and manager has been with teams that have played on that field off and on since 1914, added that "I certainly don't understand why we can't continue playing there. Mallery of the Missouri Ban Johnson baseball league will defend its title in the state's Amateur Baseball Congress tournament, starting Friday

The Muny association also has completed its draw for the annual two-losses-and-out tourney. Dick Stoughton, specialist on mathematics who used to manage Wilson Aces and Kniffens, arranged the pairings. The meet will open Aug. 24 with six games.

Announcement of the official pairings for the A.B.C. meet has been held up because of the Ban Johnson League situation. Mallory qualifies as de-fending champion, but the league may qualify a second team if it wins more games than the Mallorys. Only league champions are eligible for the A.B.C. event.

Three Games Friday.

Three A.B.C. games are scheduled Friday night at Berkeley's Champ Park, with three more games there the next night. One defeat eliminates a team. The winner again will go to the regional at Cushing, Okla. Other tourney dates are Aug. 22 and Aug. 29.

Once again the Muny tournament is on a two-losses-and-out basis, with only Berkeley and the Red Villas seeded because they ran off with league titles. Winners and runners-up in each league make the playoffs, so 14 teams will compete. Kutis North will defend its






