

Third generation student attends Lindenwood in his grandfather's honor

Lindenwood University continually attracts the best and the brightest students, making the competition for scholarships fierce. Most receive these scholarships based on their merit. Some receive scholarships based on need. All Lindenwood students compete for the privilege of receiving awards based on their talents, whether in academics, character, athletics or the arts.

Many of Lindenwood's alumni and supporters have recognized the need to help educate students and have set up endowed

scholarships in honor or memory of a loved one. One such scholarship is named for Frank B. Brockgreitens who was the Mayor of St. Charles in the 1970's. He retired in April of 1979 and was the first recipient of Lindenwood's Sibley Award in May of 1979. When he died later that year, a group of citizens and friends established the Frank B. Brockgreitens Memorial Scholarship. The Scholarship is awarded to a student from St. Charles. Barbara Brockgreitens Clark ('63) and Terry Brockgreitens Rau ('71) have monitored the funds throughout the years. This year the Frank Brockgreitens Memorial Scholarship was awarded to Chris Rau.

Chris, a junior studio art major, says he is honored to have received the scholarship named for his grandfather, "It's a great way to carry on my grandfather's name. I like the idea that he will continue to be honored in this way."


Chris came to Lindenwood as part of a long line of family traditions. He will be the third generation on his mother's side to graduate from Lindenwood and the sec-

ond generation on his father's side. But that is not the only reason he chose Lindenwood. "I like the small classroom size and the fact that I can talk to my professors and they know how I am doing. 

A friend of Lindenwood is a friend indeed: Supporter Spotlight

Lindenwood has had many friends throughout her 175-year history. These friends have helped out in times of need. They have supported her by sending students and talking to people in the community about all the good Lindenwood does. These friends, like Colonel and Mrs. George Butler, have been strong financial backers to the University. Ray and Grace Harmon are two such friends.

The Harmon family began their support of Lindenwood in the 1930s when Ray's father taught philosophy and religion to the young women who attended the school. When Ray was in the sixth grade, he began taking violin lessons from Gertrude Isador, a teacher at Lindenwood. He was her only male student. Ray's attachment to Lindenwood continued, as his sister, Jeanne Huessemann graduated from Lindenwood and began teaching in the Mathematics Department, a career that lasted for 29 years. In 1983, Ray became a member of the Board of Directors and by 1992, he was elected Chairman of the Board.

Ray has seen a lot of changes during his time at Lindenwood. "I think one great accomplishment has been the growth. The growth began when Dennis Spellmann came on board and it hasn't stopped since. The school was literally ready to close. Now, Lindenwood is completely out of debt and is building new buildings and adding more land. Lindenwood's greatest accomplishment, however, is the quality of the students and the excellent educational opportunities."

Ray and Grace continue to be strong advocates of Lindenwood University. Like Colonel and Mrs. George Butler who provided financial and verbal support, the Harmon's have

also provided well for Lindenwood. Harmon Hall was named for Harmon family. They named an honors award for students who excel in the study of religion. The Harmon's have contributed to the Performance Arena and the new Spellmann Campus Center, as well as many other projects. Ray and Grace are members of the Butler Society and have added their support to Lindenwood's Endowment Campaign. The Harmon's, on a routine basis, support Lindenwood by referring students and talking about Lindenwood University in the community.

Ray and Grace's entrepreneurial spirits have led them into careers that involve education, healthcare and religion. Following Ray's graduation from Washington University, the Harmon's began Nursery Indenta-Foto in 1955 in Washington D.C. The company began by taking newborn pictures at four hospitals with one and a half employees. Today, known as Growing Family, the company serves over 2,700 hospitals, taking over 80% of the photos of newborns in the United States, all the photos in Canada and most of the Australian born babies. They have contributed back to the hospitals in excess of \$140 million. Ray's sense of community also includes his activities as an elder at the Presbyterian Church.

Ray feels Lindenwood is an institution people can be proud of and is happy to be such a big part of the growth. "Lindenwood has been operating in St. Charles for 175 years and we plan to be around for 175 more. It is simply an exciting place to be a part of. The potential of serving both tradition and adult students is tremendous."

Butler Society

The Butler Society is named in honor of Colonel James G. and Margaret Leggat Butler, Lindenwood's most generous supporters during the 1900's. Today the Butler Society honors a distinguished group of loyal friends who have followed in the Butler's footsteps by committing their resources to promote the rich beritage of Lindenwood and to support its vision for the future.
