



In appreciation we wish to thank our many friends who helped us in making this new Plat Book of St. Charles County.



## A BRIEF HISTORY OF ST. CHARLES

St. Charles has a significant history because of its position on the Missouri River, earliest highway to the West. St. Genevieve, St. Louis, and St. Charles all had their beginning as Spanish possessions. All three had an early French background of hunters, fur trappers, and traders. Each had a succession of Spanish-appointed commandants. Each practiced a common-field system of agriculture. Each suffered dangers from Indians and dreamed at night of tomahawks and scalping knives. All three passed eventually into the possession of France, and under the Louisiana Purchase in 1803 became a part of the United States. But St. Charles was on the Missouri.

Founded in 1769, twenty-one miles from the junction of the Missouri and the Mississippi, St. Charles was on the main road to our "manifest destiny" as a nation. It had a grand-stand seat from which it could watch the pageant of history. It offered opportunity for many of its citizens to become actors in the episodes. Not content with viewing history, they helped make it. St. Charles was a link between the history that had been made and that in the making.

Five years before Thomas Jefferson penned the Declaration of Independence, a French Canadian known as Louis Blanchette the Hunter (*le Chasseur*) built himself a log cabin on the west bank of the Missouri, in what is now Block 20, bounded by Chauncey, McDonough, and Main Streets. Blanchette thus became the founder and first inhabitant of St. Charles. He called his settlement *Les Petites Cotes* (the Little Hills) from the gently rounded bluffs that stretched away to the north. In Spanish documents the village of the Little Hills appears as *Los Pequeños Cuestas*.

The Hunter has picked the site with some care. Nearby a small stream (Blanchette Creek) emptied into the river. If properly dammed it would turn a mill wheel. Close at hand walled up a perpetual stream of pure cold water (Rock Spring). Twenty miles by land from the village of St. Louis, laid out four years before, and forty odd miles by water, he would have a ready market for his furs and skins. And to get them, he had not far to go. In the prairies between the Mississippi and the Missouri, deer, antelope, and buffalo grazed in the high grass or rested in the shade of the groves. Or if he turned his pirogue up the river, he would find game plentiful in the swamp bottoms, or along the Fenne Osage, the Dardene, and the Perigue.

Though *Les Petites Cotes* was on Spanish soil, the village life was thoroughly French. At first, Catholic priests from Cahokia, Kaskaskia, or St. Genevieve visited it occasionally, conducting mass and performing baptisms and marriages in the most commodious cabin or possibly in an improvised bower. About 1781, a log church was built, presumably under the encouragement of Bernard de Limpack, a Franciscan friar. It was on the river side of Main and Jackson in Block 15. On November 7, 1791, Manuel Perez, Captain Lieutenant and Civil Judge, reported to his government, "The undersigned have blessed at *Petites Cotes* of the Missouri a church under the invocation of St. Charles," i.e. San Carlos Borromeo, who was archbishop of Milan in the 16th century. In the following year, the log church was replaced by a frame building. When Blanchette died in 1793, he is said to have been buried "beneath the shadow of the little temple." His Pawnee wife Angelique, who died in the same year, undoubtedly reposed by his side.

From the founding of San Carlos Borromeo, the village increasingly took on the name of the church and parish *San Carlos*. Some of the earliest deeds in an endeavor to be exact record both names— "*de la paroisse St. Charles du Missouri des petites cotes.*" And, of course, after the Louisiana Purchase, *San Carlos* was anglicized as *St. Charles*.

The land system of the early settlers was the European one of village and common fields. Each inhabitant of the Little Hills was entitled to a village tract, 120 by 150 feet; an interest in the common fields down by Marais Crouche; and certain rights to pasture and fuel in the Upper Commons. In the common field, each family head was entitled to a strip of land, one arpent wide and forty long, and additional strips according to the size of his family and ability to cultivate. Each tract of about 3/4 acres was divided from neighboring strips by a shallow ditch or an unplowed strip. The Upper Commons at first stretched westward from the top of the hill, but as settlement increased the boundary was moved farther out.

The Spanish land grants to individuals are responsible for the irregular appearance of surveys in St. Charles County. In those days an immigrant would select his land and frame a petition to the Spanish Governor, offering reasons why he desired the land. If the request was granted, the survey therefore might take almost any shape and be in any part of the country. In size, too, the tracts might differ, from an average one of about 100 arpents to one that might contain nine square miles.

Exact figures on the population of the village are hard to arrive at. Sometimes it is difficult to tell whether they apply to the *Petites Cotes* or to the Whole District north of the Missouri. Victor Collot, a French traveler of 1797, wrote that St. Charles, "last settlement of civilized man," contained 200 families. Berguin de Wallon, five years later, set the population at 840 whites. Perrin du Lac, wrote in May, 1802, "The Americans come in crowds into the surrounding country, which already contains some four hundred families." Amos Stoddard in 1801 estimated the population north of the Missouri and west of the Mississippi as 1219 whites and 107 blacks. Certain it is that after the Ordinance of 1787 forbade slavery in the Old Northwest, there was an increasing emigration of slave holders to Spanish soil. And doubtless many other Americans hungry for generous land grants.

Among those who came none was more famous than Daniel Boone. Following his son Daniel Morgan Boone, who had come to the district of St. Charles in 1796, the old scout arrived in St. Charles with family and followers in 1799. Given a land grant near present day Matson and made a syndic or local justice, he spent his declining years in what is now western St. Charles County. Accompanied often by Indian Phillips, he hunted and trapped Missouri streams. In 1808 he had an ambition to reach the Platte country, but fell ill and had to recuperate at Fort Osage for some weeks. Stephen Hempstead remembered seeing him land at St. Charles with a load of furs on his way to St. Louis in 1810 or 1811. The Astorians on their way up the river in 1811 saw him standing on the river bank at Charette. Chester Harding, a St. Louis artist who visited him in 1819, said that he found him alone in a cabin, roasting a piece of venison on a ramrod. He died on September 26, 1820, at the home of his son Nathan Boone and was buried in the Bryan-Boone cemetery near Dutzow, beside his wife Rebecca who died in 1813. Members of the State Legislature made speeches in his honor and adjourned for the day in respect.

The most important men in the community were the Commandants. In 1792, a year before the death of Blanchette, Charles Tayon became chief officer and earned the commendation of the Spanish government by prompt measures he took in defending settlers from Indians. The third Commandant of St. Charles, James Mackey, is memorable as fur trader, explorer, and official. On his exploration of the Upper Missouri for the Baron Carondelet in 1795-6 he made the map that Lewis and Clark carried with them. At the time Mackey was head of the local government of St. Charles, he was also Commandant of St. Andre or Andrew, now long since washed down the river.

Another historic figure connected with St. Charles was Jean Baptiste Point du Sable, mulatto founder of Chicago, who is reputed to have lived here for several years and to have died here. Mention should be made of Timothy Kirby, Revolutionary War veteran, who commanded the militia of St. Charles, and whom Aaron Burr when he visited him in 1805 could not interest in the advantages of conspiracy. At the time of the Lewis and Clark expedition in 1804, Francois Duquette was the leading citizen of the town. Clark dined with him twice and mentioned in his diary Duquette's charming wife, his "elegant situation" on top of the hill and his fine gardens and orchard. It was Duquette who converted the old Spanish Tower into a wind mill.

Because St. Charles was the last town westward in 1804, it received considerable mention in the Journals of Lewis and Clark. Captain William Clark and the company of forty-two men waited at St. Charles for five days, May 21 to 26, for Lewis to come overland from St. Louis, where he had been busy getting Osage chiefs off to Washington. And while the expedition waited at St. Charles, the inhabitants entertained its members with dinners and balls. Three men had such a fine time that they were court-martialed and one of the three received at sunset on the second day fifty lashes on his naked back. Most of the diarists of the expedition commented on the hospitality of the people. Lewis described them as follows: "In their manners they unite all the careless gaiety and ample hospitality of the best times of France, yet, like most of their countrymen in America, they are but ill qualified for the rough life of the frontier. Not that they are without talent, for they possess much natural genius and vivacity; not that they are destitute of any enterprise, for their hunting excursions are long and laborious and hazardous, but their exertions are desultory, their industry is without system and without perseverance. The surrounding country therefore, though rich, is not generally well cultivated. The inhabitants chiefly subsist by hunting and trading with the Indians, and confine their culture to gardening, in which they excell."

When the expedition shoved off on that Saturday afternoon of May 26, the villagers and the gentlemen who had accompanied Lewis from St. Louis, gathered on the bank and raised three cheers for the explorers. The men on the boats answered with three huzzas and the firing of three guns. When the expedition returned on a Sunday afternoon two years and 132 days later, it found shelter from the September rain in the homes of St. Charles. Lewis and Clark were the guests of Basil Praulx, who lived at the corner of Decatur and Main, a site covered now by the American Car and Foundry plant. The streets names Lewis and Clark probably commemorate the camp site of the expedition, for it came to shore and camped a little below the village.

Two expeditions of 1811 were historically important to St. Charles, that led by Wilson Price Hunt to establish a trading post at the mouth of the Columbia; and that led by Manuel Lisa, racing Hunt up the Missouri to get the ear of the Sioux first. The scientists who traveled with these two expeditions entered interesting items about St. Charles in their journals, H. M. Brackenridge, under Lisa's protection, commented on the difficulty leaders experienced in getting their men away from St. Charles. "They set to drinking and carousing, & it is impossible to collect them on board." Bradbury, traveling with Hunt's expedition, told how the boatmen raised a song as they pushed the boats from shore, how it was taken up by the leader, and a vocal recitative rang out over the river.

St. Charles, town and county, was the scene of intense activity during the War of 1812. At the mercy of savages who could descend upon it by the Illinois, the Mississippi, and the Missouri, it took early measures for defense. Before war was formally declared, Nathan Boone mustered in on March 3, 1812, a company of Mounted Rangers. Furnishing their own horses, rifles, and provisions, they immediately began a patrol from Salt river on the Mississippi to Fort Loutre on the Missouri, and with the help of the regular soldiers from Fort Bellefontaine began to build a line of frontier forts— Fort Howard on the Cuivre, White's Fort on Dog Prairie, Fort Kennedy near present day Wright City, Boone's Fort in Darst's Bottom, Pond Fort south of present day Wentzville, and Coontz's Fort seven miles west of St. Charles.



## PORTAGE DES SIOUX COMMON FIELD
