

While some local teams are holding baseball meetings to organize plans for the 1958 season, Bob Solari, supervisor of organized athletics, recently stated that many clubs have failed to put their applications for baseball practice permits for city diamonds.

Deadline for baseball permits Friday, March 7. All applications should be addressed to Solari, Room 330 in the Municipal Court Building, 14th and Market Streets.

The Tandy League spring training season is expected to get underway the first week in April. However, champion Teannie Edwards' Braves will get a jump on the rest of the teams and strengthening body conditioning work around old Ville ballyards in a few weeks.

Quite a few Negro youngsters will be among American Legion Post teams this season. Here is a list of the clubs: Stockham, Aubuchon-Dennison, Anheuser-Busch, St. Louis No. 4 and Roll Calcaterra. There will also be nine other teams from Greater St. Louis.

Baseball opener is still three months away, but one of the top players of our times will make the headlines this week-end. Hank Aaron, batting star of the world champion Milwaukee Braves, will be honored for "high principle achievement in sports in 1957" by the sports lodge of Ben's Brother Aaron will receive a plaque at their Annual Awards Dinner in New York.

At this time of the year, many local Negro youngsters are looking forward to their spring training in organized ball. Perhaps the most recently happy kid would be 18-year-old Thomas Edwin Haltom, who was signed by the Cardinals to a Class D Daytona Beach, Florida, contract thereby bringing the total number in the Red Bird organization to 40. The five-foot, 11-inch, 170-pound outfielder lives at 3537a Marcus Kane and is managed by Richard Fowles. He also states this Haltom kid was a long time member of the former Tandy League baseball club and East St. Louis Midgets' outfielder and third-sacker who was signed last September by the Kansas City Athletics organization. He will report to Seminole, Oklahoma, Class D next spring. White also played with the crack Army team for two years. His home is at 2826 Taylor Avenue, over his daddy's shoe repair shop.

20-Second Rule to Be Enforced in the Texas League Games
 HOUSTON, Tex., Jan. 21 (AP) — Earlier starting times, the 20-second rule for pitchers and optional dragging of the infield were approved by the Class A Texas baseball league directors yesterday in an effort to speed up the game.
 Houston, Fort Worth, Austin and Oklahoma City agreed to try starting their single week-day games at 7:45 p.m. rather than eight. Shreveport, Tulsa, San Antonio and Dallas started the practice last year.
 Houston will start double-headers at 6:30 p.m. rather than 7 p.m.
 League directors voted to make dragging of the infield at the end of the fifth inning optional rather than mandatory. President Dick Butler said his umpires would be instructed to start enforcing the new national 20-second rule for pitchers in spring training.
 Butler said he planned to explore all possible methods for speeding up games.
