To Benjamin Jones --

For my services as a hunter & from the 20th day of June 1825 to the 15th day of October 1826 inclusive, is 15 months and 25 days..... at 20 dollars per month..... \$316.66__

Saddle Bridle and Blanket furnished..... 10.00

For services on Waggoners & Laborers, of my Step Son Benjn Robinson (who died in New Mex.) from the 1st day of June to the 26th day of November 1825, inclusive, is 5 months and 26 days. At \$20 per month..... 117.33 ½

For saddle Bridle & blanket furnished by B. R.10.00

Dollars 454.00

Received St Louis January 2nd 1827. Four Hundred and Fifty-four dollars from G. C. Sibley one of the Commissioners, in full of this account Signed duplicate.
