- It is with great sadness that we inform you of the passing of Mrs. Elizabeth Rauch Lifetime Board member of Lindenwood University. Mrs. Rauch graduated from Lindenwood University in 1944, she received the Alumni Merit Award at Lindenwood University in 1994, an honorary doctorate from Lindenwood in 2009 and was appointed a lifetime member of the Lindenwood Board of Directors in 2009. Mrs. Rauch had many accomplishments throughout her life, but her greatest joy was spending time with her family. She will be dearly missed by all who knew her.
- We are sad to report that **Dr. Gene Henderson**, former Professor Emeritus of Lindenwood University and Superintendent of the Francis Howell School District in St. Charles, Missouri passed away on Monday, February 15. There will be a memorial at Henderson Elementary, March 5, 2016 from 2-5 p.m. in the School Multi-Purpose Room. He will be truly missed by colleagues, students and friends.
