utterly impossible for any one except the Doctor to adjust that account-
I have taken much pains to effect a Settlement- but Lorr will not allow
the Acc^t. without the credits Specified in the Mem^o.- Really I don't know
what to think of the matter- it is a knotty affair I Shall probably write
you again Soon
