- **Dr. Michael Shonrock** has been on the fly, (literally, no pun intended) March 11-16, he attended **The American Council on Education** (ACE) in San Francisco, California, which is considered one of the nation's most influential, respected, and visible higher education association conferences. Then on March 17-19 he was in Atlanta, Georgia attending the **Association of Presbyterian Colleges and Universities** a private, not-for-profit organization of colleges and universities associated with the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.).
- The **Women's Golf** team won the Southwest Minnesota Spring Invitational by 42 shots, and **Madelyn Piccininni** won individual medalist honors at that event.
- Michael and Karen Shonrock held a reception for the Student
   Athletic Advisory Council at Lindenwood House on Monday, April
   4 to recognize their passion and leadership during the 2015-2016
   year. Michael and Karen also held a "Champion's Night" reception

- at Lindenwood House to recognize the amazing achievements of the Swimming/Diving Team, Men's Ice Hockey, Men's Wrestling, Women's Wrestling and Track and Field.
- Starting in the fall 2016 semester, full-time faculty and staff will be entitled to two free meals a week in the **Evans Commons Dining**Hall in St. Charles and in **Dixon Hall** in Belleville and at **Grab 'n'**Go on both campuses. ID cards will work reciprocally on both campuses. They may take advantage of the new 15 percent discount at all dining locations on campus, including the national outlets and convenience stores, the dining halls, and the library coffee shops.
- The **Men's Basketball** team won its first round game in the MIAA Tournament. The victory was the first MIAA postseason win for the Lions.
- Dr. Michael Shonrock presented **Ron Watermon**, the St. Louis Cardinals Vice President of Communications and Lindenwood Alum with the **Alumnus of the Year Award** at this year's 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Lindy's Award Ceremony.
- Women's Hockey player Nicole Hensley was inducted into the Sportswomen of Colorado Hall of Fame. She was the hockey winner of the Sportswomen of Colorado for 2016, her third time receiving that award.
- As of April 8, 2016 we have 408 of 663 employees (62%) on the St. Charles campus that have given to the **Academic Resources Center** campaign.
- The Men's Swimming team had the highest finish in Lindenwood history for any sport at a NCAA Championship event this March. The Lions scored 382.5 points at the meet, 83 more than the next closest competitor, and just 66.5 behind the champion, Queens. Serghei Golban led Lindenwood with three individual national championships. The women's team also had its best finish, coming in ninth with 166 points.

- The Women's Lacrosse team has been a top-three program in the nation throughout the month of March. Included in the team's March schedule was back-to-back wins over nationally-ranked opponents Limestone and Florida Tech by seven and nine goals, respectively.
- The following Associates and Assistant Deans were recently selected to serve in the School of Accelerated Degree Programs: Dr. Mark Lerman as Assistant Dean of the ADP Business Programs Division, Dr. Saint Rice as Assistant Dean of the ADP Professional and Technical Programs Division, Dr. Charlene Engleking as Assistant Dean of the ADP General Education, MFA, and BLS Division and Dr. Angela Holden as Associate Dean of the School. Dr. Cindy Manjounes will continue to serve as Campus Dean of ADP in Belleville.
- The Lindenwood **Gymnastics** team was featured on **KSDK's** 5 p.m. newscast on March 28. Audrey Dahlgren reported the story which promoted the upcoming USA Gymnastics Women's Collegiate National Championships at Hyland Arena (April 8-10), and the Lady Lions looking to repeat as national champions.
- Twenty-three winter athletes were named to the MIAA Academic Honor Roll, including seven from wrestling, seven from men's basketball, and nine from women's basketball. Kassidy Gengenbacher and Kyle Jolas were also named MIAA Scholar-Athletes.
- Recently a team of 8 Lindenwood students developed a campaign for Spotify (a digital music service that enables users to remotely source millions of different songs on various record labels from a laptop, smartphone or other devices) and they WON! Lindenwood is the ONLY University in the United States to receive this honor. Lindenwood will be recognized at the national American Advertising Federation conference, June 2016. This honor will garner national attention for our University.
- **Synchronized Swimming** began competition at U.S. Nationals on April 5 in Phoenix, Ariz. The event continues through April 9.

- **Roller Hockey** is seeking a national title at the National Collegiate Roller Hockey Association National Championship April 6-9 at the Cedar Rapids Ice Arena in Cedar Rapids.

Sunday, May 1 against the Washington Nationals Sunday, June 5 against the San Francisco Giants Sunday, August 28 against the Oakland A's.



- The Lindenwood Baseball Team received its first individual award of the 2016 season as Nathan Prindle has earned the MIAA Hitter of the Week.
- **Dr. Sarah Patterson-Mills** will be representing Lindenwood University Belleville and advocating the school counseling profession in Springfield, Ill on Wednesday, April 13. Dr. Patterson-Mills will also be participating in "Counselor Day on the Hill" Advocacy Day. - The School of Accelerated Degree Programs' spring quarter started on Monday, April 4 with 2,558 new and returning students in St. Charles and 594 new and returning students in Belleville. Total enrollment for both campuses is 2,558 which is a 6% overall increase over spring quarter 2015. The St. Charles campus reports an 11% increase in returning students due in part to improved student support services provided by the school's Student Success Center, Quantitative Learning Center (math and applied math tutoring), and faculty advisors.
