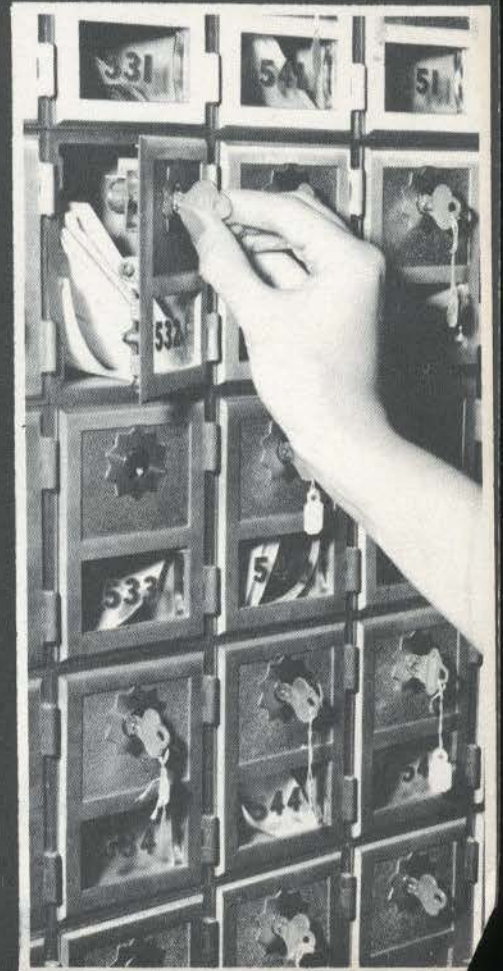

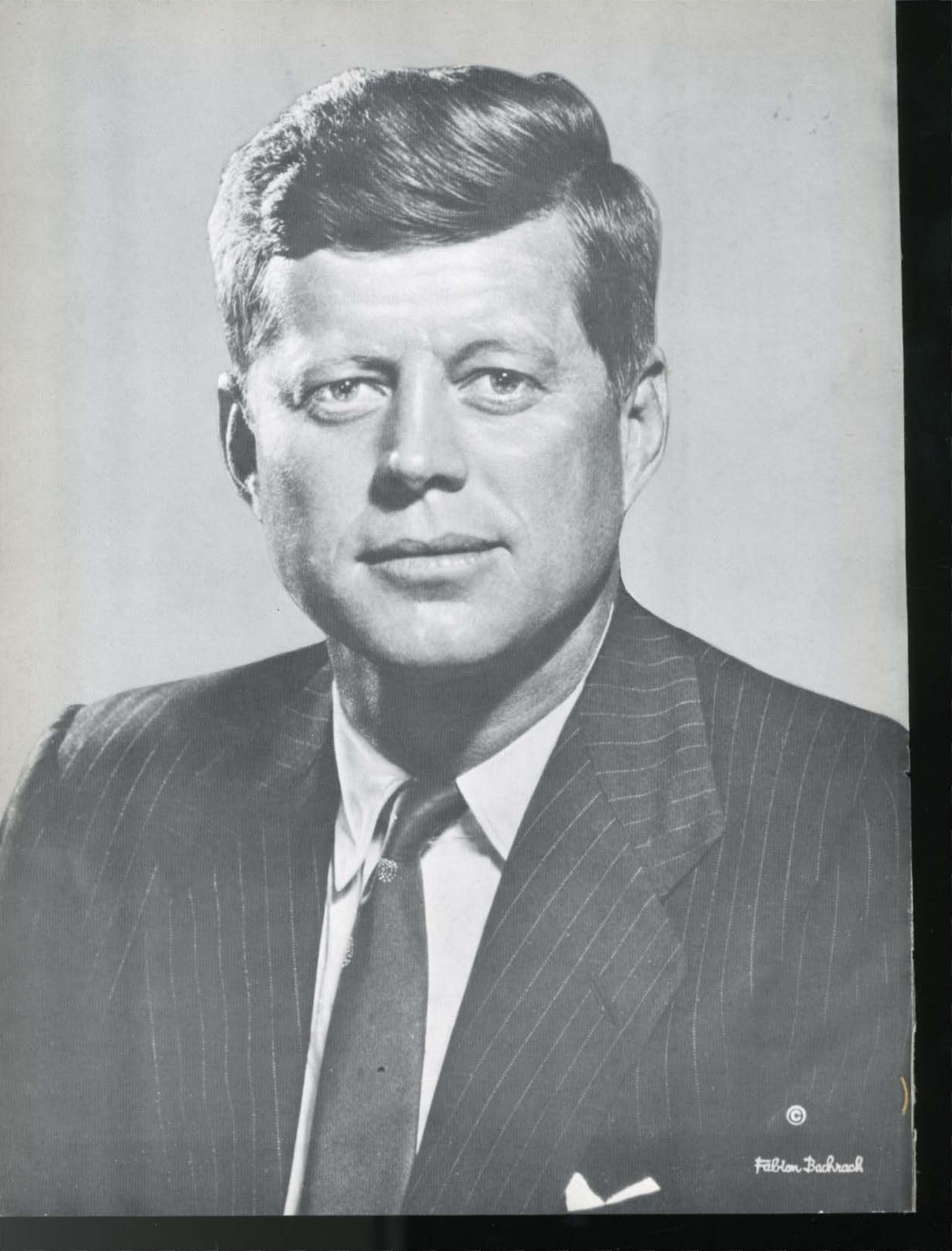

The splinters of our pains.

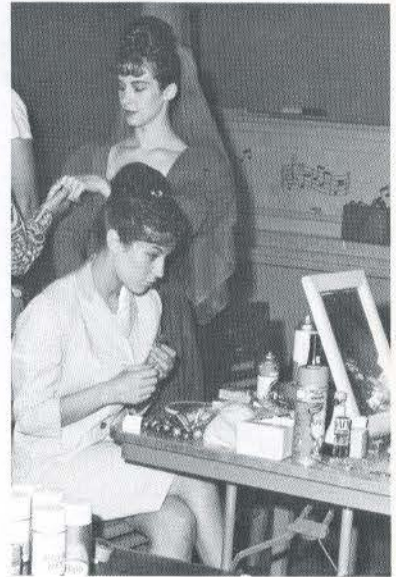
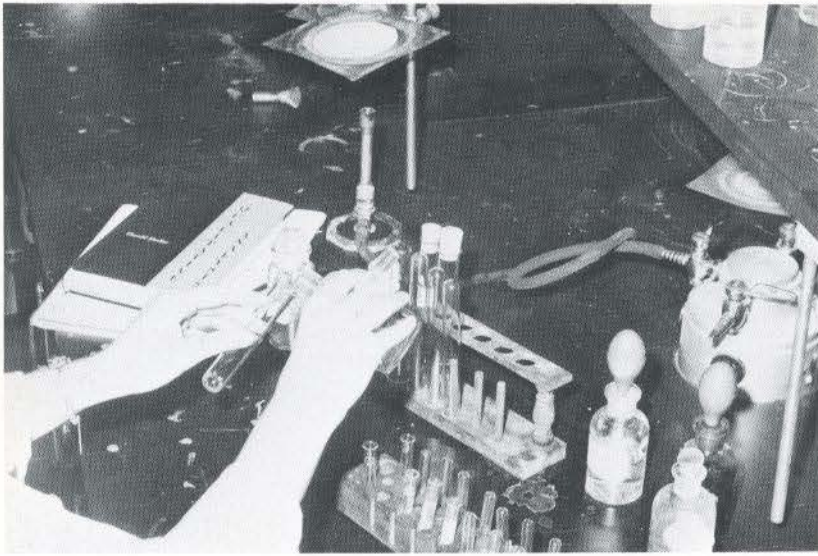
When heart and head are set at odds,

Press Club is made up of those active in the staffs of the Linden Bark, Griffin, and radio station KCLC. Its main function is the annual presentation of Gridiron.

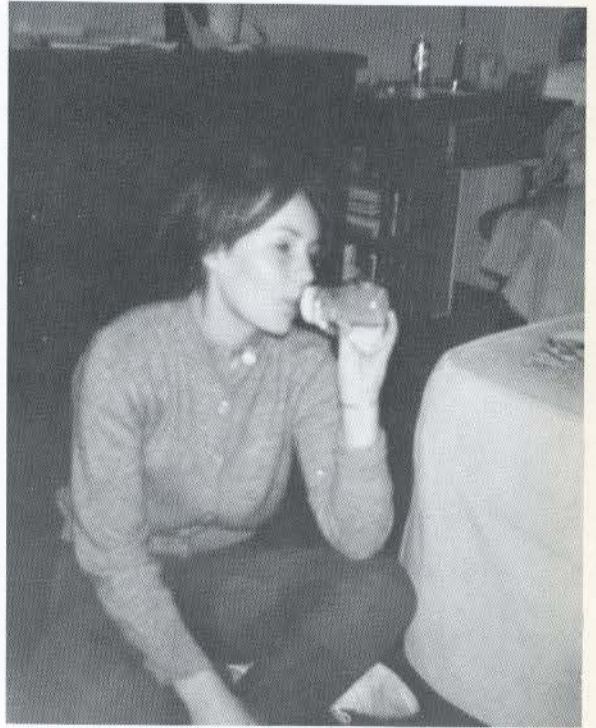
