HONORS AND AWARDS

- Lindenwood College Award for Individual Accomplishment** Sheryl Guffey
The Award for Individual Accomplishment is given annually to a student who has shown outstanding individual accomplishment in any area. The recipient for this award possesses qualities for being a success in life.
- Lindenwood College Student Leadership Award** John Creer
The award is given to a junior who has demonstrated leadership qualities in clubs, newspaper, radio work, student government, service organizations, athletics, or other student programs. The primary criteria are demonstrated caring for and devotion to the Lindenwood community.
- Lindenwood Student Government President** John Creer
Recognizing the leadership and contributions of the President of the Lindenwood College Student Government.
- Lindenwood Student Government Student Of The Year** Daniel Cummings
The Student Of The Year Award is given to the student elected by the Lindenwood College Student Government for leadership, community building, and outstanding contribution to the College.
- Kyhl Memorial Award** Arlene Taich
The Kyhl Memorial Award for Continuing Education honors the memory of Frankie Kyhl who was a continuing education student.
- St. Charles Renaissance Medal of Honor Scholarship**
The St. Charles Kiwanis Renaissance Medal of Honor Scholarship is sponsored by the St. Charles Kiwanis Club in conjunction with Lindenwood. This full-tuition annual scholarship is awarded to a student of the highest academic standards who has a proven commitment to active service on campus and in the St. Charles community. The Scholarship is the highest academic and community service that the Club gives to a student.
- Kiwanis Award of Merit**
The St. Charles Kiwanis Award of Merit, sponsored by the St. Charles Kiwanis Club, is awarded to a Lindenwood College Circle K member who exemplifies high academic standards and proven commitment to active service on campus and in the St. Charles community.
- Agnes Sibley Freshman Creative Writing Award** Elissa Kido
The Sibley Award is presented each year to a freshman student who submits work that is judged by the Lindenwood English Faculty to be the best produced in the year.

- Spahmer Award for Creative Writing** Elissa Kido
The Spahmer Award for creative writing is presented annually to the student or students whose work in poetry, fiction, drama, or essay is judged by the English Department to be the best submitted in each genre. The contest is open to all full-time students past the freshman year. Richard C. Spahmer, former drama critic for the St. Louis Globe-Democrat, established the award by bequest in 1946.

The Freshman Award honors those students whose essays, written for Freshman Composition, are judged best by the English Faculty.
- Outstanding Elementary Teacher Education Award** Linda Estes

- Outstanding Secondary Teacher Education Award** Jeanne Donovan
The Outstanding Secondary Teacher Education Award is given for service to the Education Department and the College, involvement in education activities, potential as a professional educator, and scholarship.
- Robert Mulock Environmental Biology Scholarship Award** Daryl Anderson
To be awarded to a junior student who has demonstrated scholarship, leadership and scholarly interest in the Conservation and Environmental Sciences.
- Outstanding Biology Major of 1992-1993** Daryl Anderson
Awarded to the student who has demonstrated the most outstanding scholarship, student leadership, example and interest in the scholarly pursuits in Biology.
- Outstanding Chemistry Major of 1992-1993** Kit Mao
Awarded to the Chemistry Major who is the top scholar in Chemistry and demonstrated potential for future contributions to the discipline of Chemistry.
- Outstanding Mathematics/Computer Science Major Award** John Nichols
This award is for the outstanding student majoring in mathematics or computer science, who has demonstrated a high degree of skill and understanding of the subject.
- Psychology Interest Group Recognition Award** Mary Utley-Shook, James Evans
Given to the student or students who have significantly contributed to facilitating interest in Psychology through leadership, selection of events and promotion of psychological activities.
- The F. Gilbert Bickel III Award** Gilbert Bickel III
For over a decade, the F. Gilbert Bickel II Award has been given to the outstanding business administration student. This award is donated by Mr. Bickel, a prominent member of the St. Louis investment community and a former adjunct professor of finance. The recipient, nominated by the faculty of the business administration department, is selected on the basis of grade point average and co-curricular departmental activities.

The James Magee II Memorial Scholarship honors the memory of James Magee II, who was a Lindenwood student from the Class of '88 majoring in Performing Arts. The student selected for the annual scholarship will be majoring in and working toward a career in performing arts.
