- The Lindenwood Softball team had 15 players earn academic honors in the MIAA.
- Lindenwood **Student Athletes** were well represented throughout the class of 2016. Fifty-eight NCAA athletes earned their degrees after the spring semester, and numerous other athletes also walked and will receive their degrees after the summer or fall semesters.
- **Student Life and Leadership** held 1,953 events and meetings on campus this past year for students to participate in. There were 10 new student organizations that were added, bringing the total up to 79 organizations, with approximately 1,600 involved students. Coach Weber's team finished 10th at NCAA Regionals last month and finished the Spring semester with an outstanding **3.91 team GPA**
