LU offers Historic Site Management class

Lindenwood University will offer a class in Historic Site Management this summer at its campus at the Historic Daniel Boone Home and Boonesfield Village in Defiance, MO.

The class is intended for people who work in small museums or historic houses or for people who have artifacts and want to know how to care for them. The class is also appropriate for students aspiring to work in museums upon graduation. It will run from July 17 through August 11. Classes will meet from 9 a.m. until noon on Monday through Friday during that period.

The class will be taught by Dr. Teri Jones, curator of artifacts for the Boone Home. Jones was trained at Southern Illinois University at Carbondale and has worked with collections at SIU-C, Syracuse University, the Coastal Museum Association of Georgia and the Mary Miller Museum in Brunswick, Ga. She currently teaches at Lindenwood University and catalogs new accessions for Lindenwood University.
