

The 2016 Olympics will mark the third straight Summer Olympics in which Lindenwood has had an athlete or former athlete competing. Lindenwood had three athletes in the 2008 games and five at the 2012 Olympics.

Lindenwood's 10 team members had an average GPA of 3.901. The WGCA also announced the top 25 teams with the highest team GPA, Lindenwood placed 1st. This was the highest team GPA for any women's golf team in the country, at any level!
