

Step 1: Name Your Values

Go to the <u>Learning Academy website</u> > Development Toolkits > Choosing Courage Over Comfort to access the exercise material. Start by watching the interactive video that will take you through the process of clarifying your top three values.

Three questions to consider throughout the exercise:

- 1. Does this define me?
- 2. Is this who I am at my best?
- 3. Is this a filter that I use to make hard decisions?
