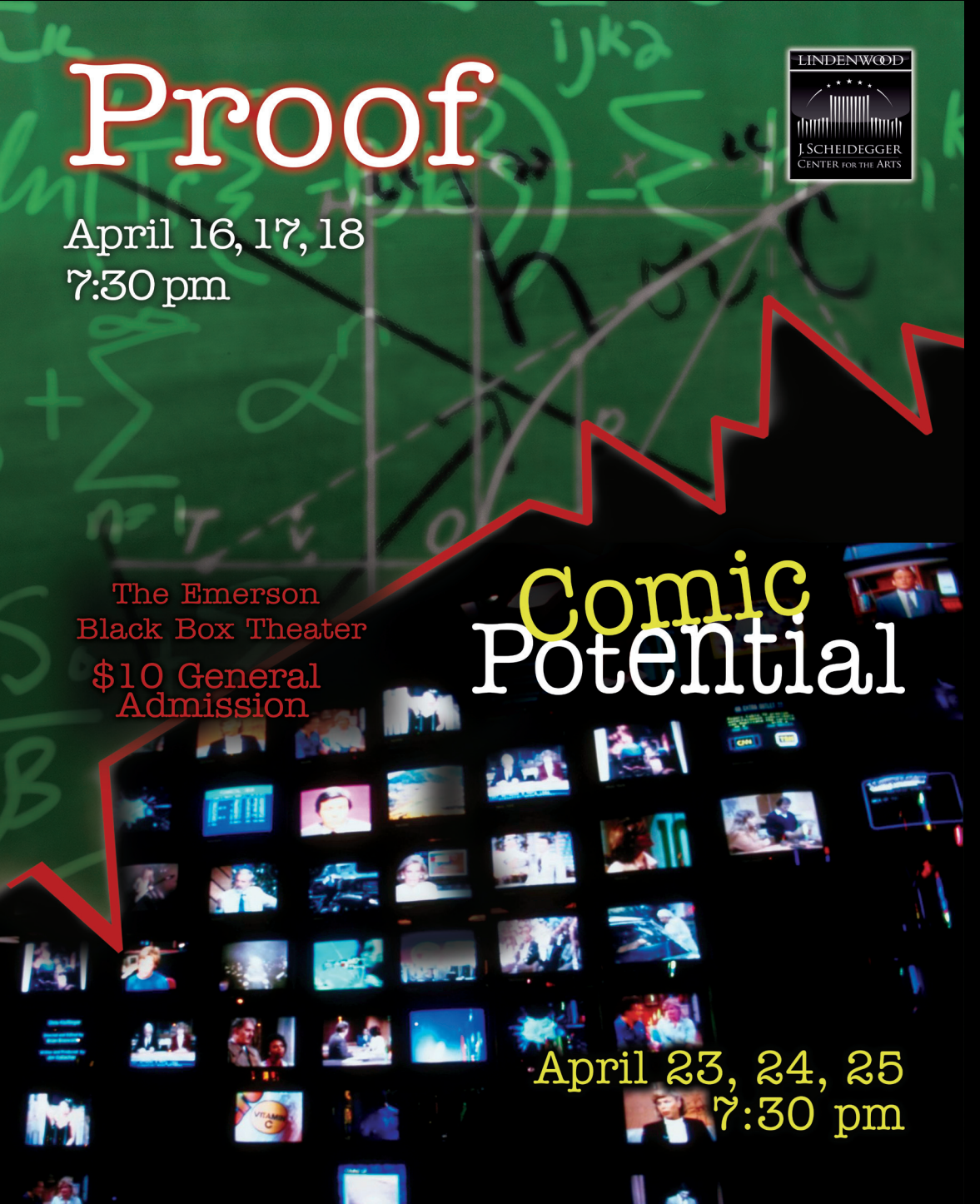

Comic Potential

With the broader and more frequent use of computer generated characters replacing real actors in movies, could androids--or actoids--on the small screen or stage be far behind? Comic Potential takes place in the foreseeable future when "everything has changed except human nature." Not only is it a cautionary tale for those of us in the acting and directing professions, but it is, in the words of John Heilpern of The New York Observer, an "amusing take on the Pygmalion myth,...bad television, romantic love, the secret of slapstick and...the farcically robotic nature of human beings." Alan Ayckbourn has provided us with a charming and refreshing comedy that is also thought provoking. The profundity of the script can be as surprising as a custard pie--hitting you in the face when you least expect it.
