You are hereby, with the approbation of the President of the United States, appointed Agent to their Factory or Trading house established at the Osage river in the Territory of Louisiana in which Agency you will be governed by such instructions and regulations as may be directed by the President of the United States

This appointment to continue in force during the pleasure of the President of the United States

Given under my hand and the seal of
the War Office of the United States
this Seventeenth day of May 1808 and
in the Thirty second year of the In-
dependence of said States.
