Henrietta Leavitt was a trailblazer who questioned our very existence who are we, why are we.....where are we. Her curiosity and perseverance charted a path for astrophysicists to measure the universe and paved the way for female scientists at the turn of the 20th century.

Lauren Gunderson's play celebrates Henrietta's accomplishments and challenges us to face our historical neglect of female scientists and the adversity they faced within the field. The additional use of historical figures such as Annie Cannon and Williamina Fleming, both remarkable in their own right, creates a powerful feminist drama.
