Youth Savings is a tiered, interest-bearing savings account. The interest rate and corresponding annual percentage yield (APY) are tiered. If he daily balance in the account is \$100.0.00 or less, the interest rate paid on the entire balance will be 48% with an annual percentage yield (5.00%, An interest rate of 0.10% will be paid only for that portion of your daily balance that is greater than \$100.0.0. The annual ercentage yield for this iter will range from \$.00% to 0.10%, depending on the balance in the account. (APY calculations are based on a total leposit balance of \$10,000.) Rate is effective as of November 1, 2018, \$5.00 minimum opening deposit is required. There is no minimum balance required or monthly maintenance fee for Youth Savings. Fee scould reduce earnings. Rates are variable and are subject to change at the bank's discretion. Rates are calculated on a daily balance method. Limited to one Youth Savings account per child. At the age of seventeen 17), the account will be converted to a Statement Savings account and will be assessed a \$3.00 service charge if the balance falls below 100.00 at any time during the statement cycle.
