Here's how you find Lindenwood Content library in LinkedIn Learning:

1. Log into LinkedIn Learning using your LU credentials.
2. On the home screen, click "Content" located on the left side of the screen.
3. Next, click on "Lindenwood University", located at the top of the screen. (See first image below for steps 2 & 3)
4. This will lead you to Lindenwood's content on LinkedIn Learning where you can find videos and documents
