Her family and friends say that Lisa Marie Tighe had a true passion for life that most of us could only dream of having.

A native of O'Fallon, Missouri, she loved children, music, literature and volleyball. Lisa attended Assumption Grade School and St. Dominic High School.

Throughout her adult years, she focused on two very important things: the well-being of her family and continuing her education. Going to college would prove to be a true financial struggle for Lisa and her family, but they all felt it was a sacrifice well worth making. Lisa entered St. Charles County Community College and later transferred to Lindenwood to pursue her dream of studying psychology. She consistently made the dean's list at both schools, and maintained an outstanding grade point average. At the same time, she set an example for her children, and never failed to remind them of the importance of education.

Lisa was scheduled to graduate today. Last August, while attending a family reunion, she was thrown from a horse and died from head injuries. Upon her death, her son Aaron told his father, "Now Mom will never get her degree."

Today, Lindenwood College is pleased to present an honorary bachelor's degree in Lisa's name to her husband Ronald and her children Christen and Aaron. We also welcome Lisa's family and friends who are celebrating with us; her parents Joan and James Brengle, Sr., her sisters Sandy Mueller, Mary Beth Pech and Paula Stephens, her brothers James Brengle, Jr., and Greg Brengle, and her very good friend Catherine Neier.

ACADEMIC DRESS

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn by the faculty and students at this graduation are today's formal dress of the worldwide academic community. While now worn only on such festive occasions as commencement, such dress was originally the normal garb of academics as they went about their daily business. Originating in Europe more than a thousand years ago, like universities and colleges themselves, academic dress first developed within the Church and all academics were once at least in minor orders within the Church. The robes and hoods are stylized versions of these monastic robes. The style of robe indicates the highest degree earned by the wearer--Bachelor sleeves are pointed, and the robe is plain. Master's robe sleeves are oblong, while the doctoral robe sleeve is gathered at the wrist, and the robe itself has velvet bands. Another badge of the doctoral degree is a gold tassel worn on the cap.

The hoods indicate both the academic area of degree and the school which granted it. The outer band of the hood indicates, by color, the degree; the bright, silken interior of the hood, by its colors and design, indicates its source. Each university and college has a distinct hood. An increasing number of doctorate-granting universities today fashion their own doctoral robes, using institutional colors.

The colors of the mortarboard tassels worn by today's degree recipients, as well as the hoods worn by faculty and graduate students, indicate the major fields of study.

THE COLLEGE SEAL

The Lindenwood College seal, mounted on the gazebo rostrum, was fashioned of stained glass by *Professor Emeritus John Wehmer* after his redesign of the family crest of College founders Mary and George Sibley. The Sibley Crest can be seen on the chimney of the fireplace in the Margaret Legget Butler Library. The seal is also centered on the College flag. The elements of the crest represent both the founders of Lindenwood and the mission of the College. The griffin symbolizes vigilance and eagerness in pursuit, while the crescent moons signify those who have been enlightened and honored by their sovereign. The colors on the crest also have meaning. Half the shield is red, symbolizing military fortitude and magnanimity; while the other half of the shield is blue, the color of loyalty and truth. The silver of the crescent moons signifies peace and serenity.

THE MACE

The mace, carried in the academic procession by the Faculty Marshal, symbolizes the authority of the College's President. The mace is a staff of linden wood, surmounted by a silver cup, originally belonging to President Roemer. It is used only on occasions such as this one when the Faculty and its President march in formal procession. Since academic customs originated within the medieval Church, the order of procession follows ecclesiastical custom, with the most honored members of the procession at the end; thus the President, preceded by the Marshal, follows the other members of the academic community into the Commencement area.

HONORARY DEGREES

For centuries, colleges and universities have awarded honorary degrees to worthy recipients for institutional and societal contributions. These degrees, awarded *honoris causa* ("for honorary cause"), represent the College's most time-honored way to recognize significant service and achievement.

COLLEGE HISTORY

Lindenwood College was founded in 1827 by Mary Easton Sibley (1800-78) and Major George C. Sibley (1782-1863). The institution was incorporated by the Missouri Legislature in 1853, making it America's second oldest institution of higher learning west of the Mississippi River. Today, fully independent, the College is in a covenantal relationship with the Presbyterian Church.

LINDENWOOD COLLEGE...

A Proud Past and A Promising Future

Amidst the beautiful linden trees, Lindenwood College was founded on the highest ground between two rivers nearly 170 years ago; today, it is the second oldest institution of higher learning west of the Mississippi. Since 1827, when it was founded by pioneering educator Mary Easton Sibley as a school for young ladies, it has enjoyed a reputation as an innovative force dedicated to liberal education in the highest sense and meaning of the term.

Mary Sibley, along with her husband Major George Sibley (himself a prominent pioneer and frontiersman, who helped chart the Santa Fe Trail), sought to establish an institution which reached across all fields of knowledge, teaching a solid academic core along with the balanced sense of self-worth which accompanies dedication to the larger community and nation...an institution which was always up-to-date with the times, in teaching both the breadth of the liberal arts along with the attention to detail of the sciences, seeking to synthesize all knowledge in an effort to educate the whole person.

Lindenwood has changed through the years, in keeping with its innovative, pioneering heritage. Since 1968, the College has broadened its horizons by developing fully co-educational programs. Since 1974, a number of new programs and delivery-formats have been offered at both the undergraduate and graduate levels to meet the ever expanding horizons of our student population...a population which now includes a wide-range of working adults and professional people, in addition to record numbers of traditional aged college students. The Lindenwood College of Individualized Education (LCIE), an innovative accelerated program designed especially for working adults, celebrates its 20th anniversary this year. This program has been cited as a national model for adult learning programs.

This academic year, a record 5,000 full and part-time students will attend classes at Lindenwood College. One-thousand of those students have lived and worked on the beautifully-wooded residential core of the College. Campus residence halls and classrooms buildings are newly renovated and modernized. The chapel in historic Sibley Hall has been renovated and redecorated, and is now ready for use as a chapel, lecture and recital hall. Two months ago, Lindenwood broke ground on the largest building project in its history, a 3,000 seat performance arena that will provide a spectacular venue for college athletic and cultural performances. The College is in the process of implementing a state-of-the-art information technologies system, and has updated Macintosh and personal computer labs for student use. These are just a few examples of how Lindenwood continues building upon its innovative heritage by modernizing today to meet the promise of tomorrow.

The innovative, pioneering sense of spirit toward education which the Sibleys challenged Lindenwood to share with its students is certainly flourishing today. Today, more than 11,000 alumni continue to distinguish themselves in virtually all fields and walks of life, reflecting not merely their excellent academic preparation, but their development as complete, balanced, whole persons. Lindenwood continues that tradition by responding to the culture and needs of life today in preparing liberally-educated (not merely specialized or trained), responsible citizens, seeking to balance formal learning in the classroom with a wide range of extra and co-curricular experiences designed to truly provide education for life-long learning...education which continues to prepare individuals for success, as responsible citizens, while insisting that they be their very best selves.
