

DIRECTORS NOTES

It started with the report in June 24, 1992 "Bat Boy found in West Virginia Cave." Then he escaped and went on a tristate highway chase. He was caught only to escape again and enlist with the Marines. In April 2004 he was knighted by Queen Elizabeth and also led the Marines to Saddam. After his heroism, he was linked to shared DNA traits with James Carville.

All of these reports were investigated by the Weekly World News. Almost as reliable as Fox News.

These reports were followed by the Actors Gang in Los Angeles which created Bat Boy: The Musical with Laurence O'Keefe. This is a fun run through the woods, a romantic, scary, heartbreaking, unusual and most of all incredibly beautiful story created to tell the origin of the character in the Weekly World News.



ED ASNER STARRING AS FDR

This one-man show takes us through FDR's White House years, including the Depression, the steps leading up to WWII, and the war years. Edward Asner shows us why this president was known as "that man in the White House," scorned by many and admired by most.

We see and hear his fireside chats; his controversial packing of the Supreme Court; his personal life with Eleanor and his discreet but definite affair with Lucy Mercer; his courage to break the Neutrality Act; his manipulation of Congress (in order to get the country to have a draft); the Pearl Harbor controversy; and the benevolent dictatorship he called the presidency from 1933 to '44, which made him the only man in U.S history to be elected to four terms.

Asner is an American actor primarily known for his Emmy-winning role as Lou Grant on The Mary Tyler Moore Show and its spin-off series, Lou Grant. He also appeared in a recurring guest role as Wilson White on the television series Studio 60 on the Sunset Strip. As the recipient of seven Emmy Awards (Mary Tyler Moore Show, Lou Grant) and 16 nominations, and five Golden Globe Awards, and as a member of the TV Academy Hall of Fame, there is no doubt that Asner is prepared for the challenge of bringing such an iconic president to life before your very eyes.


