## Due Date for Final Grades SU MBA 19

The deadline for SU MBA 19 final grades to be entered into Canvas is July 30 at 5 p.m. IT will pull the grades from Canvas and upload into CAMS on July 31. Please

enter all special grades (AH, I, N, or AF) in your faculty portals by the July 30 deadline. The attachment explains how to enter special grades into faculty portals.

**AF:** This grade is given when a student stops attending a particular class prior to the published deadline (July 5, 2019) to receive a grade of W but does not withdraw from the course. The grade of AF is treated as a grade of F in the calculation of the student's grade point average.

**N:** A grade of N is assigned when a student appears on the roster but NEVER attended the course. Students should receive a never attend grade if they do not complete any assignments for online courses. Once verified, the course will be dropped from the record and will not be listed on the student's transcript.

**I:** A grade of I (incomplete) is given at the end of a term only for incomplete coursework due to exceptional circumstances beyond the student's control, such as an extended illness, hospitalization, or death of a close relative requiring absence from class for a significant period of time. When assigning an incomplete grade, the professor should consider whether the student is capable of successfully completing the course. Incompletes should be offered only toward the end of the term for students who are, at the time, successfully completing the coursework.

A grade of I (incomplete) must be resolved prior to the end of the subsequent term; otherwise, the incomplete automatically becomes an F. Any request to extend the time needed to resolve the grade of incomplete must be submitted to the Office of Academic Services no later than two weeks before the date the grade is due. Requests will then be sent to the appropriate school dean and the associate provost to be considered for approval.
