#### Library Resources go to Single Sign-On

On Aug. 1, the library began updating its database resources to use OpenAthens for database access, which will streamline access to databases to be part of Lindenwood University's Single Sign-On service. Logging onto library resources will now look the same as logging into Canvas or Office 365. Once the switch is complete, any links to library resources that you have bookmarked or saved must be updated, as the other system will stop working on Sept. 30. ### Lindenwood Ranked Fourth Among Private Universities in Missouri and Kansas

Ingram's, the Kansas City business magazine, published a ranking of private

universities and colleges in Missouri and Kansas in its July 2019 issue, based on post-graduate enrollment. With a fall 2018 graduate enrollment of 2,862, Lindenwood ranked fourth between Saint Louis University and Webster University. The list was attached to an article, "<u>Grading Higher</u> <u>Education</u>," in which Lindenwood was also mentioned for the number of master's degrees it conferred in 2017—1,181, which was the sixth most among institutions in the two states.


