

The Honorable Patricia Roberts Harris

Mrs. Harris is a native of Mattoon, Illinois, and grew up in the midwest. She enrolled in Howard University in Washington, D. C. where she was awarded a research assistantship during her junior and senior years, was elected to Phi Beta Kappa, and was graduated summa cum laude.

After completing her undergraduate education, Mrs. Harris returned to the midwest where she pursued a graduate program in industrial relations at the University of Chicago and worked as a program director for the YWCA. In 1949 she again went to Washington, D. C. and continued her graduate studies at American University while working as Assistant Director of the American Council on Human Rights.

She served as executive director of her sorority, Delta Sigma Theta, for six years. In 1955 Patricia Roberts married William B. Harris, a Washington attorney and member of the law faculty at Howard University. As a lawyer's wife with an inquiring mind, Mrs. Harris decided to learn more about law herself, and enrolled in the law school of George Washington University. She graduated at the top of her law class and was awarded the Juris Doctor degree in 1960. She spent a year as an attorney with the Justice Department, but then moved back to the college community she enjoyed so much, as Associate Dean of Students and a lecturer in Law at Howard University.

Mrs. Harrishad not been back on the campus long, when President Kennedy appointed her co-chairman of the National Women's Committee for Civil Rights. In 1964, President Johnson appointed her to the United States-Puerto Rican Commission on the Status of Puerto. Rico. Meanwhile, at Howard University, she had given up her deanship and had been promoted to Associate Professor of Law. Then, her country called again. In 1965 Mrs. Harris was appointed Ambassador to Luxembourg. She has since represented the United States as the chairman of our delegation to the 22nd Plenary Session of the Economic Commission for Europe, served as a delegate to the Third Committee of the 21st General Assembly of the United Nations, and continued her service on the Commission on the Status of Puerto Rico.
