Committee Admits

Applicants who fall below our standard admission profile for acceptance can be admitted through the Committee Admit process. These students are reviewed by a committee of senior admission officers and the faculty ASPC committee. It is not unusual for Committee Admitted students to struggle academically at Lindenwood, and many leave the institution before completing their degree. For these reasons, the goal

this year was to reduce the number of students admitted via the committee review process and reduce the number of Committee Admits enrolling this fall. Last year, ten percent of all admits were Committee Admits. This year, that number is less than four percent. Seventeen percent of the new students who enrolled last fall were Committee Admits, this year less than seven percent are Committee Admits, and the goal for 2019 is to drop that percentage to less than five percent.



Pepsi Meeting Held on Campus

Common Application


This year, Lindenwood University joined over 800 other institutions around the world as a Common Application school. The Common Application is an undergraduate college admission application that applicants may use to apply to any of the member colleges and universities in 49 states and the District of Columbia, as well as in Canada, China, and many European countries. The

mission of the Common App is to promote access, equity, and integrity in the college admission process. To date, we have received 20 applications via the Common App for fall 2019.
