DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Good evening,

The story of *The Last 5* Years is simple enough; there are only two characters, and it is not set in some distant land or during some long ago time, but the play is complex in its structure. The show follows the relationship of Jamie and Cathy over the course of five years. We first encounter Cathy at the end of their relationship (not a spoiler, I promise) and at the end of their story. As she progresses through the show, her timeline moves backward, so by the end of the show, she is at the beginning of their relationship. Meanwhile, we are introduced to Jamie at the beginning of their first date and follow his timeline as it hurtles forward to the inevitable end of their relationship. The timelines cross only once, at their wedding, and quickly separate again. This story is not about the outcome; we know how it will end at the beginning. Instead the journey is what proves to be the most important thing in these characters' lives. We see how important love is to everyone, and what a challenge it can be.
