# The Lindenwood Colleges

Lindenwood is a cluster of four colleges with the main campus in St. Charles, and satellite campus offices and classrooms in Clayton and Lake Saint Louis, as well as on-site business and hospital programming.

Each of the Lindenwood Colleges has its own identity and primary program focus which reflects the needs and interests of its student population. But like a family, each college is part of a whole dedicated to excellent education and personalized student services. At Lindenwood, the student and the faculty form close relationships in both learning and guidance. Individual attention is a key to Lindenwood's success.

The hallmark of The Lindenwood Colleges is quality. Lindenwood is accredited by North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools to offer programs leading to a bachelor or a master's degree. Other accreditation includes National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE) and the State of Missouri Department of Education.

## Lindenwood 1&2

Formerly Lindenwood College for Women, founded 1827, and Lindenwood College for Men, established 1969, Lindenwood I and II now form the St. Charles campus daytime-based classes for younger students. A complete Liberal Arts education is offered within a traditional classroom format.

## Lindenwood 3

Located on the St. Charles campus, the Evening College offers classes for young people and adults who aren't able to attend daytime classes. A wide selection of courses is offered, with business drawing the largest enrollment. Evening College offers the MBA degree and the BSN degree in addition to other undergraduate liberal arts degrees.

## Lindenwood 4

The College for Individualized Education is designed for the working adult. It is an innovative concept in adult education which focuses on the adult learner's career goals and educational needs. Degree programs are either traditional or highly individualized. Classes are held both in St. Charles and Clayton. Lindenwood IV offers liberal arts and business degrees on both the undergraduate and graduate level. It also offers specialized programs at the masters level in such fields as Business Administration, Art Therapy, Counseling Psychology, Teacher Education, Theatre Arts, Valuation Sciences, Voluntary Association Administration, and Health Administration, as well as custom-designed degrees on a contract basis with the student.

## Weekend College of Lindenwood 4

In response to the expressed needs of the business community, Lindenwood IV is sponsoring a Weekend College in which students can earn an undergraduate or graduate business degree on the weekends. The program will begin Fall 1980, and will be based in Clayton and St. Charles. The program is a full-time course load geared to the working adult and will feature the Lindenwood IV individualized format.

## On-site Courses

The Evening College and Lindenwood IV sponsor on-site course work for business, nursing and health administration professionals..

## Continuing Education

Lindenwood Colleges offers continuing education courses on its St. Charles campus. In addition, Lindenwood IV sponsors a LUNCH & LEARN program at noon in its Clayton Office. These courses are designed for adult enrichment. Some also serve as pre-college entry refresher courses.

## Lake Saint Louis

Both continuing education and college credit courses are currently being offered on-site at Lake Saint Louis.
