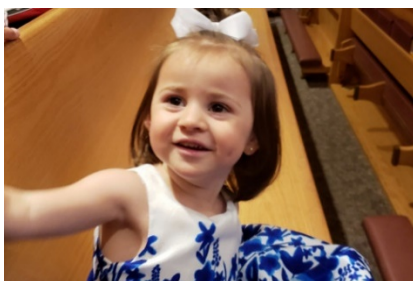

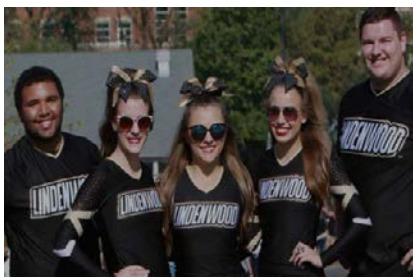

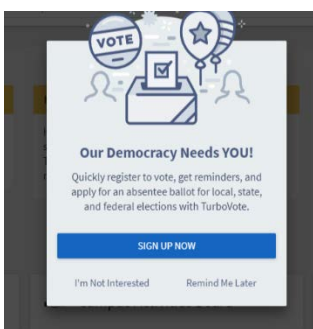
Emmy-Award Director Speaks to Students

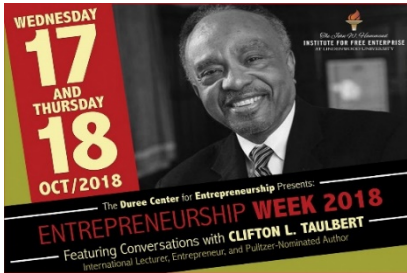
Turbo Vote

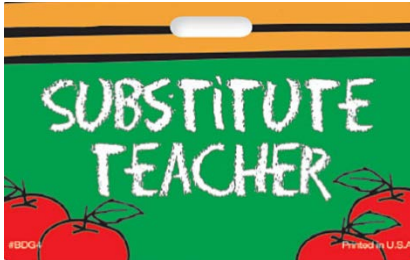
Belleville Exercise Science Department Published
