**LINDENWOOD UNIVERSITY  
IMPACTS THE REGION'S ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:  
THE UNIVERSITY:**

- ◆ Employs over 700 faculty and staff, with local payroll of \$20,000,000 annually.
- ◆ Has completed over \$100,000,000 in new facility construction and acquisition during the past ten years, and plans an additional \$125,000,000 in the near future.
- ◆ Is currently building a 1,200 seat performing arts center in St. Charles, and renovating a 900-seat auditorium in Belleville, Illinois to enhance the arts.
- ◆ Sponsors 38 college sports teams with over 200 public home athletic events.
- ◆ Educates students without benefit of direct tax subsidy, saving Missouri taxpayers almost \$70,000,000 annually.

**ADDRESSES THE REGION'S WORKFORCE NEEDS:  
THE UNIVERSITY:**

- ◆ Serves almost 16,000 students annually, with over 3,000 full-time residential students at the St. Charles campus.
- ◆ Produces over 2,200 graduates each year.
- ◆ Has increased tuition only once in the past five years, and provides over \$30,000,000 in scholarships annually.
- ◆ Ranks # 1 as the largest provider of graduate teacher education degrees in Missouri.
- ◆ Is the primary source for the preparation of new school principals in the state.

- ◆ Houses the Center for the Study of Business and the Environment, that provides seminars on a variety of environmental topics.
- ◆ Is home to the Rivers Edge Policy Institute, a forum to study and debate education issues.
- ◆ Partners with American Humanics to educate the next generation of not-for-profit agency leaders.
- ◆ Provides expertise to school districts and businesses in addressing planning, research, and training needs.
- ◆ Operates the Daniel Boone Home and Boonesfield Village, and sponsors the Center for the Study of American Culture and Values.
