Sir,

Your favor of the 30th ult. Arrived this morning. I shall send to you, the report on the committee on claims, in the case maintained by you, if you have no vouchers, and the nature of this service would not permit you to obtain them; fact should be stated, and unified by oath, the number of days, during which the commissioners were employed: and in which branch of the service, must be stated and verified by oath, the commissioners should produce all the evidence in their power, in support of their services, the expenditure of the many and the sale of the property at the time services ceased.
