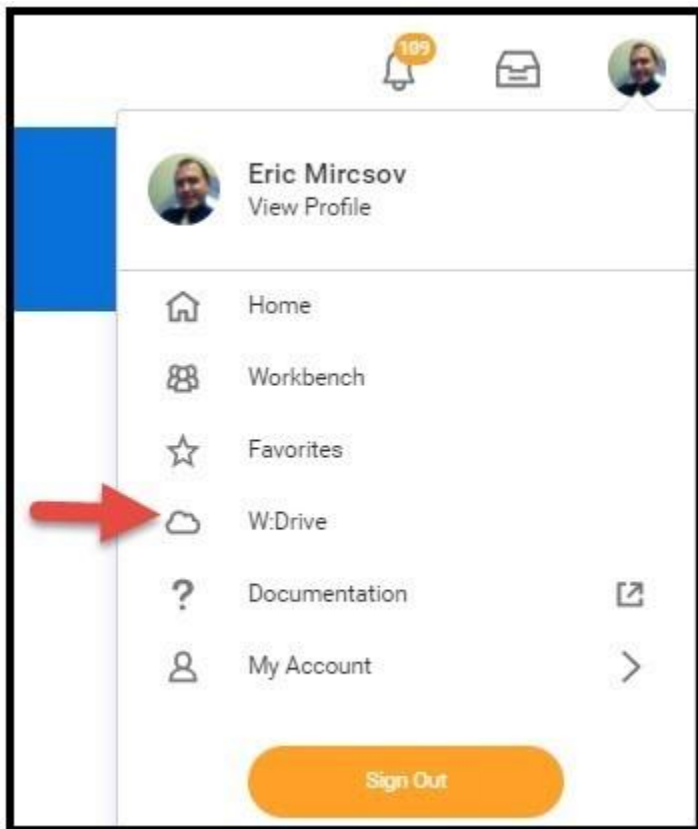
### Presenter Needed for Leadership Series
