Your letter of the 4th Ulto. requesting to be furnished with authority to proceed with your work beyond the boundary line of the U. States is received; and in the absence of the Secretary of War, I have to state in reply that instructions were given to Mr. Poinsett before his departure for Mexico to obtain such authority from the Mexican Government as early as practicable; and it is hoped you experience no delay at the boundary line of the U. States for want of the necessary instructions from the Mexican Government to the local authorities, to allow you to proceed with your work.
