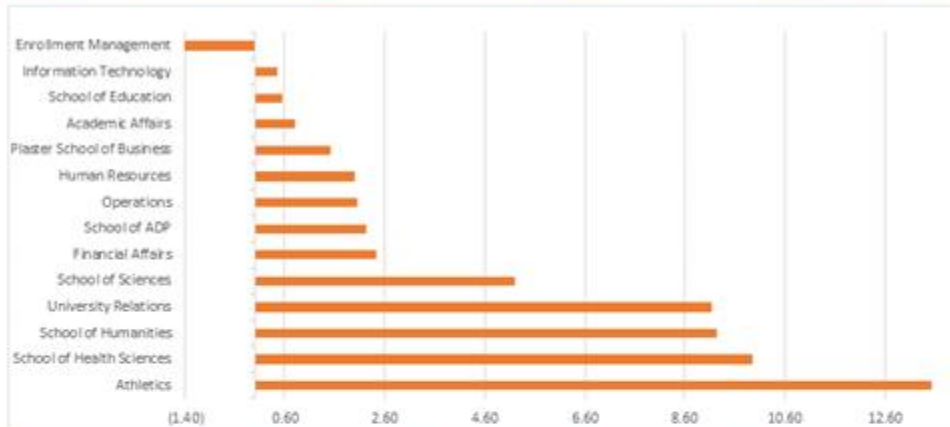


Linden Scroll Seeking New Advisor


