# Assessment Tip of the Week: "Reminder: Assessment Plans Are Due October 15, 2018

All assessment reporting units (academic, co-curricular, administrative) should submit your 2018-19 assessment plans by October 15, 2018.\* An assessment plan consists of the <u>first three columns in the Nichols 5-column template</u>. This is an opportunity to document any changes your program is making relative to the items in those first three columns (e.g., changes to program outcomes, methods of assessment, or criteria for success). Remember that your 5-column reports will be due on June 15, 2019\*; having your plans in place now will position you for submitting those final reports. Read more
