The Confluence Partners with National Park Service on Commemorative Arch Issue



The Confluence, the regional studies in a magazine format published by Lindenwood, created a partnership with the National Park Service and the Gateway Arch National Park to publish a commemorative issue for the opening of the new museum at the Arch.

The issue, now on sale at the Gateway Arch museum gift shop and Whitehaven (the U.S. Grant National Historic Site), includes articles that expand on topics in the new exhibit including an

archaeological dig on the Arch grounds, the Arch design competition, and Mormon migration to St. Louis in the 1840s and 1850s.
