

Patterson-Mills Panelist for Illinois Principal's Association Webinar

On Wednesday, May 2, Dr. Sarah Patterson Mills was a primary panelist for a live webinar to Illinois Principal's Association Professional Development organization. Patterson-Mills created the content for the webinar and delivered the content with several current, past, and future Illinois School Counselor Association Presidents. The webinar was the first of its kind for the Illinois School Counselor Association and was initiated and coordinated by Patterson-Mills.

Three Belleville School Counseling students contributed original evidence based approaches to the metric section along with a few schools in the Chicago Public School System. Joelle Macke, Michael Turner, and Traci Gardner used multi-tiered interventions in their field experiences to produce solid evidence for their data informed interventions.
